Campanula: Commonly known as 'Bellflower'

Native to many regions the versatile Campanula, or Bellflower, is a long-blooming, alpine native perennial ideal for borders and rock gardens. True to the name the Bellflower has bell-shaped blooms commonly found in shades of blue, lavender, pink and white. Full sun to partial shade the Campanula enjoys soils with moderate moisture but once established can tolerate periods of drought. Easy to care for maintenance is usually a rejuvenating haircut in the early spring as new growth emerges and the optional deadheading, to promote new blooms, in the summer.
