Chrysogonum (Commonly known as 'Goldenstar' or 'Green and gold')

Native to the Eastern United States, the Goldenstar is an easy-to-grow wildflower most often used as a groundcover for moist, shady sites. Plants form a low spreading mound of dark green leaves spring through fall. In the springtime Goldenstar is abundant with long lasting, small, bright yellow star-shaped flowers. It is a wonderfully easy groundcover that pairs well with hostas, ferns and other plants that appreciate moist, shady sites. Spreading through rhizomes, Goldenstar is easy to grow and maintain.

- Beautiful groundcover for shady areas
- Easy to grow and maintain
- Spring blooms last forever
- Perfect for rain gardens, both shade and partial sun

(Ideally a shade perennial, in the right environment will adapt to partial sun areas that meet its needs)
